

MASTER MARINER 2026



The 2026 Master Mariner will take place at the Commissioners of Irish Lights on 7 March 2026.

Logistics

- Participants will arrive at the Commissioners of Irish Lights at 08.30 on 7 March. It is hoped to run a night navigation exercise. This will determine the finish time. If it doesn't go ahead, finish will be around 17.30. If it doesn't, finish will be approx 22.30 (with overnight option available). This will be notified asap. Participants should arrive in uniform.
- Venture Scout participants should be accompanied by a Scouter for the duration of the event.

Preparation

- Syllabus is available at seascouts.ie. In their preparation, participants are advised to pay specific attention to the Steering Rules and Navigation sections..
- This year for the Venture Scout and Rover Scouts Advanced Module/Research Project, participants should consider the role of physical Aids to Navigation in the modern world. A briefing document will be available in January 2026.
- They should be able to explain something of interest, why it interests them any relevance to their Scouting/studies/career/interests. They should be able to speak about the topic for 4-5 minutes. It will be available on the Master Mariner page on seascouts.ie
